Strengths

- Adequate sun light but not able to grow quality & export oriented crops
- Adequate labour force. 60-70 % farmers depend on Agri
- Range of climate/ crops/ seasons
- Enough rainfall but less than 50% irrigated area
- A large area under canal system but seepage/ evaporation losses
- Enough Resources but Poor Management

Weakness

- Shrinking land holding
- Low productivity per unit area
- Higher post harvest losses/ Unorganised Marketing
- Lesser realization- APMC norms vary state to state
- Decreasing water level- Alarming droughts
- Erratic rainfall/ Decreasing water availability for agricultur
- Higher seepage & Evaporation losses Increasing water logged and brackish area
- Inadequate access to markets, information, Govt data

Organic Farming (Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY)

Lowering use of Chemical Fertilizers

- Mobilisation of farmers in clusters- Expense related
- Training of farmers
- Community infrastructure for preparation of biopesticides & bio-fertilizers, Nitrogen fixing plants.
- Soil sample collection & testing
- Process documentation- inputs used, cropping pattern, certification charges.

.....Organic Farming (Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY)

- Any natural pest control mechanism Neem cake
- Vermicompost Procurement of earth worms, pits, raw material.
- Agricultural Implements custom hiring
- Walk in tunnels
- Packaging, Labelling and Branding of Organic produce
- Conduct of organic fairs

Horticulture (Cultivation of F&V, flowers, coconut for higher income)

- Vegetable seed Production Rs 1.5 lakh per ha
- High tech Nursery raising- INR 25 lakh per ha
- Small Nursery- Rs 15 lakh per ha
- Establishment of new gardens Rs 4 lakh per ha
- Integrated package for strawberry, banana, ultra high density.
- Growing spices, flowers, aromatic plants, plantation crops, mushrooms.
- Creation of water resources- Community tanks
- Protected cultivation, shade net house, Anti bird/ hail nets, plastic tunnel.
- Cost of planting material, Mulching
- Pack house, pre cooling, cold room, mobile pre-cooling unit, Cold storage unit, Refrigerated vans, Ripening chamber

- Bee keeping- Bee stock, colonies, Distribution,
 Equipments
- Production & Distribution of seeds- Pulses, oilseeds, foddor, green manure crops, Seed infrastructure.
- Creation of Seed Reserve- maintenance cost, sheds, drying platforms, fumigation, spraying etc.
